

CAYETANA BLANCA PEDIGREE DIAGRAM

This very old variety has played a central role in the Iberian peninsula by giving birth to no fewer than sixteen natural offspring, arranged here according to their geographical origins, from left (Portugal) to right (Spain) and from top (northern Iberian peninsula) to bottom (southern Iberian peninsula). The presence of unknown (and probably extinct) varieties (?) means that the inverse relationships are also theoretically possible (see p x).
